I want to thank all the authors and reviewers who collaborated with us for reaching such unbelievable results, all with a common and pervasive aim: contributing to the dissemination of researches, results and applications in the field of transportation. Surely, in 2003, thirteen year ago, when the first issue of ATS was published, nobody of us, even the most optimistic, could have expected such remarkable accomplishments.

In fact, since 2003, 485 papers have been published in ATS. All these papers have been referred by at least two reviewers through a blind peer review process. On average, from 2003 to now, 10% of papers submitted to the Journal for possible publication have been accepted in the original form, 40% have been accepted after one or two round of reviews and about 50% have been rejected after review, with a rejection rate that has grown from 30% in the early years up to almost 60% in the last year, making ATS a very selective journal.

We continue to focus on publishing high-quality papers with long-term reference value based on timely management of paper reviewers. Time of publication varied from three months to maximum one year from the date of submission.

More than 1000 authors from over 60 different Countries all over the world have been contributed to ATS success, publishing their research in one or more issues among the 39 ordinary issues and 16 special issues published in ATS up to date.

All these few data here presented provided you just a picture of the great success and excellent improvements of ATS during these past years. However, it must be seen as one step in a long journey and not as an end in itself.

Thank you for everything you have always done in the past and for all that you will do in the future to reach our common objectives and lead to ever higher goals and results our loved ATS journal, disseminating the most recent and effective outcomes of advanced research in the field of transportation.
